In the course of his professional career, Alex Fohl worked successively as a bank employee (1988-1989), teacher (1995-1997), proof reader, journalist and columnist (1997-2008) before being appointed as a political adviser and editor in 2008. Besides, he is working as an artist, guest speaker, consultant, producer and publisher. In 2016, he took the lead of an international Art Promoting Company based in Luxembourg.
